Have you ever thought about water? Some countries like Japan can get water very easily, so most of the people in those countries may think that water is 'just' water.

Almost all of the restaurants in Japan serve free water. Japanese people may not think that it's special. But, if you go to some restaurants in Singapore, you may ask this question "May I have some water, please?" You may have to ask a clerk to bring a glass of water for you, and sometimes you have to pay money for it too. Some Japanese people will be surprised to hear that.

The Restaurant Association of Singapore said in 2015, "At some restaurants in Singapore, you must pay between 30 and 80 Singaporean cents (25 to 66 Japanese yen) for a glass of water." A restaurant which serves free water usually pays SG\$5,000 to SG\$10,000 (411,300 to 822,600 Japanese yen) every year, and it also loses other drinks' sales. Other drinks' sales are over 20% of total sales of a restaurant. That is a very big problem for such restaurants.

① Maybe you cannot often see warm water in the restaurants in Japan. Customers in such restaurants in Singapore can choose warm or cold water. For the restaurants and the customers in Singapore, free water may not be 'just' water, I think.

I will talk a little about myself. When I was younger, (than / liked / warm water / I / better / cold water). My parents used to teach me that drinking cold water was not good for our bodies. But I didn't believe them. I couldn't find any scientific studies which said that drinking cold water was bad for our bodies. Some books said that cold water is good for weight loss, and some said that we should drink warm water when we have a stomachache.

These days, however, I usually choose warm water. It's because I can feel very well when I drink it. I never thought that I would start enjoying it, but I found that warm water is better for my body. 3

My parents are happy to see me now.

Fortunately, I can get water easily in my town, so I didn't think so much about water when I was young. But I think we should think that water is not 'just' water. This story is not only about water. We should think more about other different things around us. If we watch one thing more carefully, that will (④) us something important or new.
