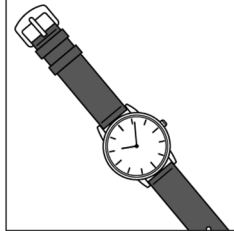

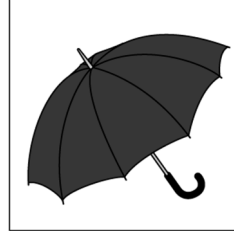

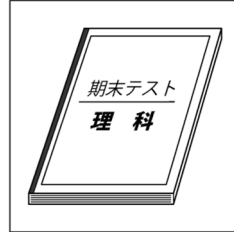

Dear Sota, Thank you for your email. That was a very good question. There are many programs like those children's cafeterias in other countries, too. In the U.S., we have one called the "National School Lunch Program." It gives free or low-cost school lunches to children. During summer vacation, free meals are given to children in places like parks or libraries. In some cities, food trucks bring meals to children's houses. I also know about activities in other countries. In the U.K., there are places called "Community Cafés." Anyone can eat there even if they don't have money. Some people pay a little money, and others eat for free. During school holidays, they also have special programs for giving food to children. In Australia, there's an activity called the "Breakfast Club." It gives breakfast to children before classes start. Some children can't eat at home, so this helps them. Before they had this activity, some children couldn't focus on their classes. But thanks to the Breakfast Club, they can study hard from the morning. Each country has its own good points. In big cities, people can easily see a doctor. When they feel sick, they can go to a hospital near their homes.

Today, new technologies are solving this problem. One important solution is telemedicine. People can talk with doctors online by using smartphones, tablets, or computers. The doctor can ask about their symptoms and give them advice. Sometimes, the doctor finds out the cause of the disease. Thanks to telemedicine, people don't always need to go to the hospital.

In Japan, more people are starting to use telemedicine. During the COVID-19 pandemic, many doctors and patients started to use it because it was sometimes (イ) to stay at home than to go to the hospital. However, there are still some problems. First, many elderly people don't know how to use smartphones or computers. Second, some rural areas don't have good internet connections. Because of these problems, it is difficult for some people to use telemedicine.

To solve these problems, local governments are holding classes to エ(1 to / 2 way / 3 teach / 4 the / 5 elderly people / 6 use / 7 the internet). The Japanese government is also working to improve internet connections in rural areas.

Other technologies are also helping doctors. For example, robots with cameras are used in small hospitals and homes. Doctors in big cities use these robots to see patients living far away. This is very useful when there are few doctors in rural areas.

Drones are also useful tools. In some places, they are used to carry medicines to hospitals in the mountains and on islands. Drones can fly anywhere, so people can get treatment more quickly.

In the future, more people will be able to use telemedicine and other medical technologies. They can help doctors give better care, and patients can feel safer and live better lives. All people should have the right to quality medical care.
